HOW TO ENTER?

Each entry may consist of up to three images without any entry fee. Write Your Name, Contact Number, Course, and Photo Caption; and submit it by mail in accordance with the instructions.

RULES FOR SELECTION

- Individual entries need to be sent **BEFORE 20TH AUGUST 2015**.
- An individual can send a maximum of three entries.
- Photos can be clicked using DSLRs, Digital Cameras and Smartphones and should contain the date and time info with a minimum resolution of 1600x900 pixels or greater.
- Submissions should not be watermarked.
- Softcopies must be at least 1 Megabyte or maximum 10 Megabytes, Format of photographs must be in JPEG or JPG.
- Post processing of any type isn't allowed. In-built Camera presets and filters can be used.

- The photograph, in its entirety, must be a single work of original material taken by the Contest entrant. By entering the Contest, entrant represents, acknowledges, and warrants that the submitted photograph is an original work created solely by the entrant, that the photograph does not infringe on the copyrights, trademarks, moral rights, rights of privacy/publicity or intellectual property rights of any person or entity, and that no other party has any right, title, claim, or interest in the photograph.
- The caption must be complete and accurate, sufficient to convey the circumstances in which the photograph was taken.

JUDGING CRITERIA

- Photos will be judged on subject matter, composition, technical quality, creativity, and originality.
- Photos will be judged on the basis of artistic and technical merit, but more emphasis will be placed on the ways in which the photo captures the students' experiences.
- Captions will be judged on the basis of how they describe the ways in which the photo captures the students' experiences.
